

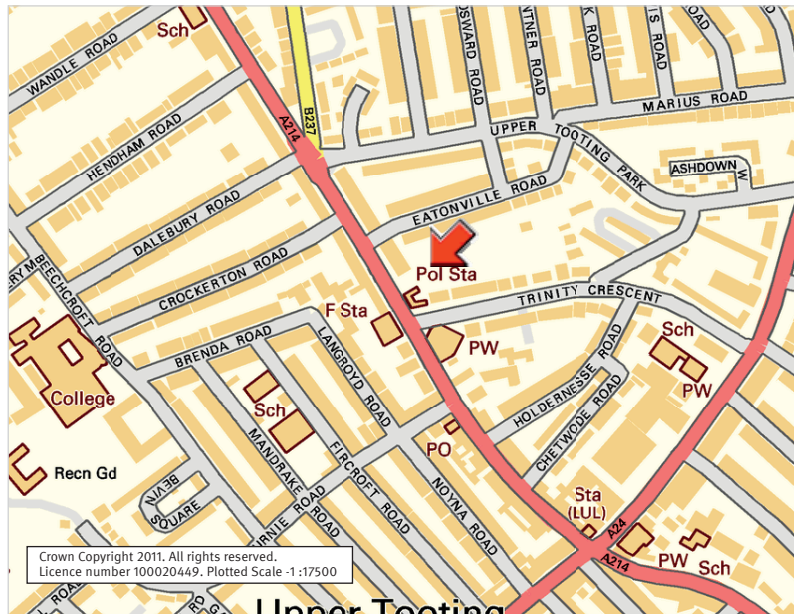

Location

The property is located c.7 miles south of central London and is situated in the London Borough of Wandsworth. The site is located on Trinity Road (A214) which connects with Wandsworth Bridge to the north and Streatham to the south east. Tooting Bec Tube Station, (Northern Line) is c.0.2 miles to the south east, whilst Wandsworth Common train station with regular services to London Victoria is c.0.6 miles to the north. Regular bus services are within close proximity to the property.

Description

The site comprises a substantial period red brick former police station. Internally, the buildings comprise a mixture of office accommodation, locker rooms, training rooms and WCs. There is a substantial car park to the north and east of the property with access from both Trinity Road and Trinity Crescent.

Legal Title & Tenure

The property is held freehold. All pertinent legal information is available on the dedicated website. The property is sold subject to and/or with the benefit of any rights of way, easements or restrictions, which may exist, whether or not mentioned in these particulars.

Planning

- ◆ Whilst the building is currently used for offices, the lawful use of the site is Sui Generis and planning permission will therefore be required for any future use.
- ◆ The building is neither locally or statutorily listed.
- ◆ The property is located within the Wandsworth Common Conservation Area.
- ◆ The property has potential for residential development as a conversion with extension or redevelopment, or other uses, subject to the necessary consents.

Areas

The site extends to 0.33 acres (0.13 ha) and the buildings extend to 4,541 sq ft (421.8 sq m) GIA. Floorplans are available the dedicated website.

Fixtures and fittings

Any items of furniture or other items left in the properties will become the responsibility of the purchaser on completion.

Services

It is our understanding that mains water, electricity, gas and drainage are provided. However, it is the responsibility of the purchaser to ensure that services are available and adequate for the property.

Inspection

Method of Sale

Forward Sale Clawback

The sale contract will include a "forward sale clawback" awarding 50% of any uplift to be paid to the Metropolitan Police Service if the site as a whole or in parts (but not any individual units) is sold within 5 years without planning permission. If the site is sold on with planning permission then the clawback will be 50% of the uplift in the site value at the date of the sale discounting any increase in value due to the planning permission or capital improvement to the property.

Tender Procedure

Bids must be received at these offices by noon on Friday 9th September 2011. The bids will be sent unopened to the MPS immediately after this time. Late bids will not be accepted.

If the bids are not received in the correct format, or by the deadline above, they may be invalidated as being non-compliant. Please note faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted, even if these are received before the deadline.

The vendor, in its absolute discretion, does not undertake to accept the highest nor any offer received.
